

Episode 10 - The Ballad of East Broad Street

"Teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom." Psalm 90:12

"Their work will be shown for what it is, because the Day will bring it to light. It will be revealed with fire, and the fire will test the quality of each person's work." 1 Corinthians 3:13

1. What are some ways that you number your days? Count-down to vacation, etc.

2. Interact with this statement: "You gain knowledge quickly; but wisdom slowly."

3. After reading all of Psalm 90, how do the following words appear in the Psalm and what do they teach us about gaining wisdom:

Eternity Serenity Frailty Stability Accountability

4. Read 1 Corinthians 3:10-15. In what ways is Jesus the permanent foundation of our lives?

5. Give examples of the gold, silver, wood and hay that we use to build on our life's foundation.



6. When we pray for God to teach us to number our days, we are asking Him to help us evaluate the livestream of our lives. This requires us to slow down. In what ways do you slow down so God can teach you how to number your days?

7. Numbering our days is an act of reverence where we acknowledge the significance of each day. It's helpful to look back at recent days and practice seeing the treasure in them. In some quiet time, ask God to reveal to you the gold and silver as you review the last week or two. Write down what you find.

8. How will next week's investment of your time and effort and prayer *change* as a result of your "numbering your days"? How will you build in order to receive a reward (1 Cor 3:14)?
