- 1. Read Psalm 80:1-3 and Exodus 20:1-6. How is God's power and His warmth spoken of in these passages?
- 2. How have you experienced His power? His warmth?
- 3. In what ways does the gospel of Jesus display God's power and warmth? See Romans 3:23 and 5:8-11.



- 4. In what circumstances do you need to know His power? 2 Corinthians 12:9-10.
- 5. In what circumstances do you need to know His warmth? 2 Corinthians 1:3-7
- 6. Reserve some private time to praise God for His power. Reflect on how His power affects your sense of accountability and discipline for the time you are granted on earth. How does His power affect what you believe He can do in your life or through your life?
- 7. Reserve some private time to thank God for His love and warmth. Name moments and situations. Say thank you. Ask for the blessing of Numbers 6:24-25. Pray this blessing for specific people in your life who need it today.
